### **Tutoring objective:**

Objective of the tutoring will be to ensure an optimum of transfer of know-how and develop capability to use it in the context of NRAs and TSOs functions.

### **Tutoring content:**

The tutoring will include:

- familiarization with ISPRA structures and organization: Illustration by the tutor of the ISPRA roles and activities in the field of decommissioning and waste management
- familiarization with regulatory requirements and applicable standards. Decommissioning plans and their status
- evaluation of Operator documents related to decommissioning planning. Issues encountered

- participation to Operator –NRA meetings to get evidence of regulator’s licensing management capability, type and content of interfaces between regulator and applicant and between regulator and external technical support
- participation to onsite inspections to get evidence of the complementarities between regulatory safety review and regulatory inspections.
- Preparation of tutoring report common to both tutees.
