

EU Training Course on “Public Information & communication”

Duration	1 Week
Content	<p>The training course will present and discuss the legal basis, the objective, content and responsibility for public information and communication with focus on the role and responsibility of the Nuclear Regulatory Authority. Importance of Regulator’s communication, Involvement of stakeholders, communication requirements, key aspects of communication during siting, operation and decommissioning of a nuclear facility, crisis communication and public information management while developing a nuclear program will be covered with experience from EU countries.</p> <p>The course will introduce the basic requirements for tools, methods and approaches for public information, regulators tools for public communication, role of media in public information and communication. Need to develop a communication program and aspects affecting an “effective” communication will be discussed.</p> <p>The course will underline the importance to ensure correct and transparent public information and the progress made in EU in this field with ENSREG initiatives and the content of EU Directives. Availability of Information Centre at the NRA. Feedback and lesson learned from international experience. Reference standards and guidelines will be addressed. Practical applications on key aspects of public information and communication are included in the training program.</p>
