

<b>Regional Training Course on “Regulation of uranium mining”</b>

<b>Content</b>	<p>The training module will introduce and discuss the different regulatory aspects for uranium mines. They include the site preparation, construction, operation, decommissioning and release from regulatory control. The key issues to be covered by a regulatory guideline for uranium mining will be presented together with the content of safety documentation to be submitted to NRA for licensing, approval and authorization. Occupational safety aspects to be regulated and Environmental aspects and radiological impact connected with uranium mine operation and subsequent decommissioning will be outlined. Reference standards and guidelines for regulatory review will be presented. Practical elaboration and evaluation will be included in the training program.</p>
